





JSDC Outreach Programs

MOBILE FOOD PANTRY

Travels to 20+ locations weekly, delivering over 13 tons of groceries each month to communities in need who don't have access to local food banks. This program has grown by over 163% since 2020.



FREEDOM MINISTRY

Supports families affected by incarceration and those recently released from prison by delivering groceries, clothing, and spiritual support. This program was officially launched in February 2022.

BABY PANTRY

Provides families in need with diapers, wipes, and baby supplies, distributing 8,000-10,000 diapers each month. Diapers are not covered by SNAP or WIC benefits. This program has grown by over 300% since 2020.











With your help, the Jersey Shore Dream Center proudly distributed 125 brand new bikes, locks, and helmets to children in the greater Asbury Park area as part of their annual Serve 24 event. Serve 24 is a day dedicated to spreading love and serving the local community in big, unexpected ways.

Since this year is JSDC's 10th anniversary, we wanted to do something extra special. We originally wanted to purchase 100 bicycles and opened a fundraiser for the cost. We secured discounted pricing from a supplier, meaning that each donation could have a greater impact. For each \$100 donated, we were able to purchase a bike, lock, and helmet. The outpouring of generosity was amazing. We had so many people that donated that we surpassed our fundraising goal by \$2,500 and were able to bless an additional 25 children!

The bikes were distributed on Saturday, July 16th, at Springwood Park in Asbury Park. This happened during our free community event that is part of Serve 24. The event included a DJ, bounce houses, food, sweet treats, and more. The JSDC volunteers went out into the community after the event for various outreaches, such as paying for people's laundry at local laundromats and hosting pizza parties at some of our mobile food pantry stops. We are excited to bless our local children in a new way this summer!
